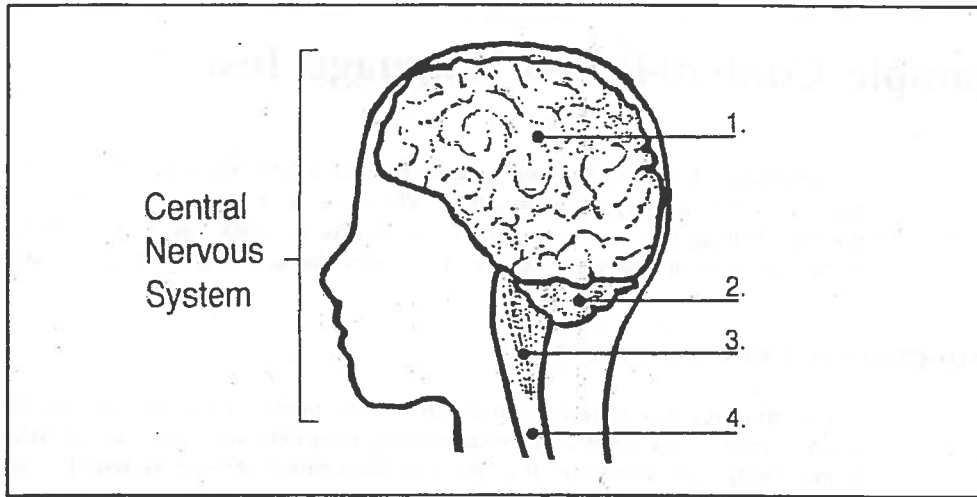


**INSTRUCTIONS:**
